## Lawrence Community Center - We're Open!

Happy New Year, Lawrence!

The Lawrence Community Center is open, with safety in mind, for programs to utilize space. When the pandemic hit, we were able to keep our doors open for social services. We did, however, have to end all community programming. In June of this year we started safely bringing existing programs back, and at this point, all that have chosen to resume are back up and running. We have been able to do this because of the safety precautions that we set in place. Upon arrival, everyone's temperature is taken and they are asked to use hand sanitizer. Everyone must be masked in common spaces, all surfaces are disinfected daily and we installed special UV rays in our HVAC systems to purify the air as it goes through the return vent. All of these precautions have set us up to now be able to bring in new programs. As a reminder we have a full court gym, conference room, large multipurpose room, art room, computer lab and two classrooms. 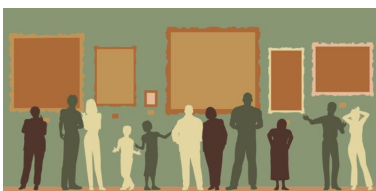
